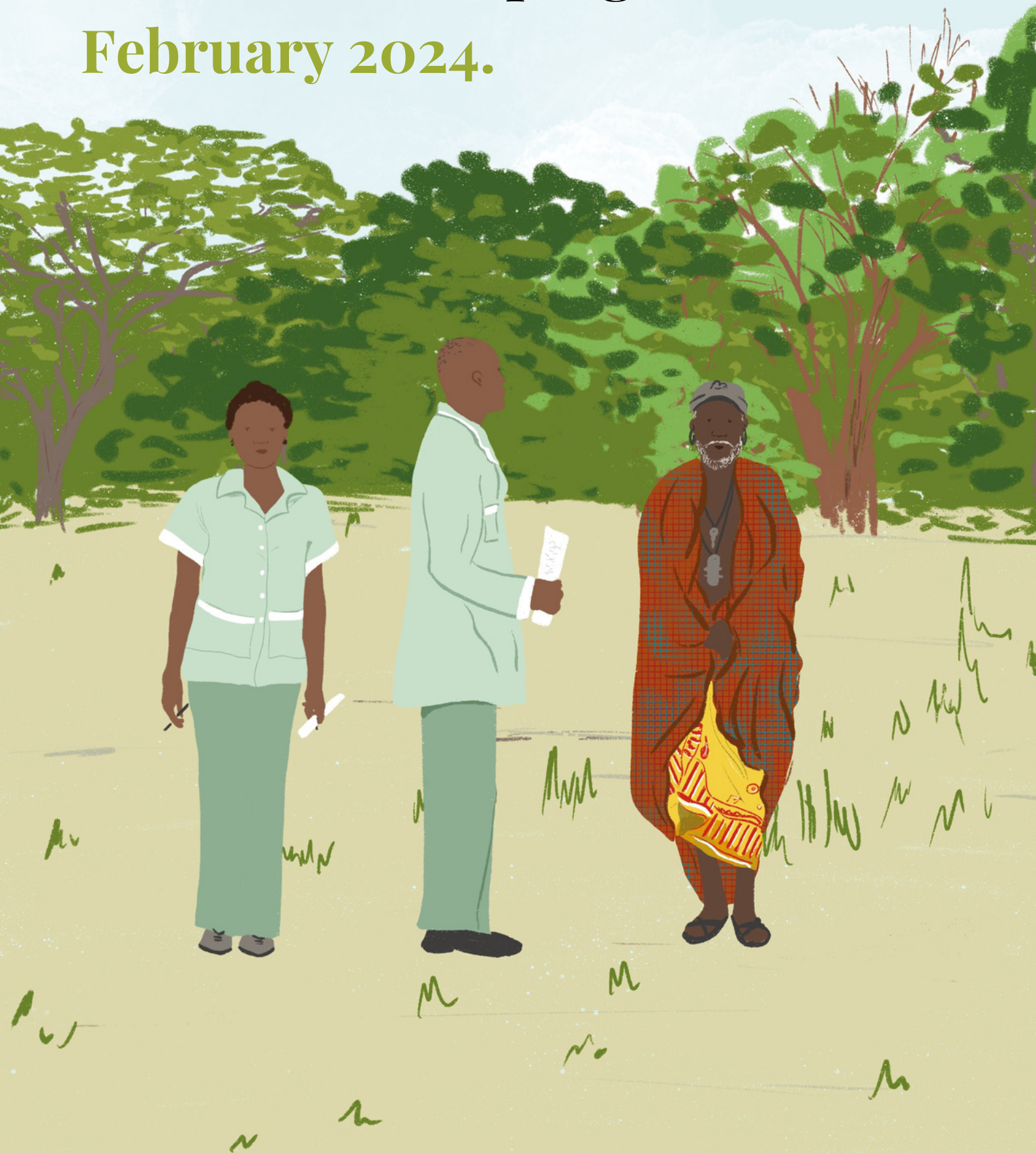

Malaria rapid test, It detects *P. falciparum* only. Preventive tablets for pregnant women only and seasonal malaria camp.



How many people are protecting themselves and how (nets, antimalarial medicines....)

Preventive tablets for pregnant women only. Most of the people cannot afford medication

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Locate mosquito *Anopheles* breeding sites
(e.g. lake, river, water well....)
