lity: how many people died of malaria in 2024

**7 children and 4-5 adults die every quarter.
25 + people died in 2024, with the floods exacerbating the situation.**



Morbidity: how many people have malaria?

2000 people- year 2024- floods being a contributing factor for the increase as compared to 2023

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Prevalence: the % of the population that is affected by malaria at a given time period

What are they doing about malaria right now

The Government is working on the drainage system to allow flow of stagnant water caused by floods.

The government has introduced Malaria vaccine for under 5

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How many people are protecting themselves and how (nets, antimalarial medicines....)

Few families are trying to protect themselves using mosquito nets but during our home visits we realized they are torn.

Preventive tablets for pregnant women only.

70% of the people cannot afford prevention and treatment medication

- **2 at IIMSAM Kisumu Spirulina centre (awareness to children and workshop to personnel at the centre)**

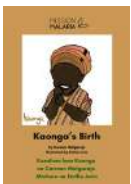
